



## MARCSTA Induction Card –

### *Lost/Stolen/Original Not Received/Replacement*

MARCSTA requires a Statutory Declaration in order to protect the integrity of the certification system. It is imperative that we prevent the misrepresentation by an impostor that he holds a MARCSTA certificate by using the name, and more frequently the number of the certificate to convince an employer that he is MARCSTA certified.

A Statutory Declaration by the person who, for whatever reason, has lost, had stolen or, in some cases, does not receive the card alerts MARCSTA to the situation and enables us to re-issue a replacement card.

The fee for replacement meets our administration charges and ensures we do not have continual requests for replacement from persons who do not adequately protect cards. The process is not dissimilar to replacement of a drivers licence.

*ie: Justice of the Peace, Commissioner for Declarations, town/shire clerk, deputy town/shire clerk, council member, electoral registrar, officer of the Commonwealth or State public service, teacher, police officer, bank manager, legal practitioner, medical practitioner, pharmacist, real estate agent, insurance broker, auditor, liquidator, chartered/certified public accountant, or a member of the State or Federal House.*
- **Enclose administration fee of \$22.00 (inclusive of GST) for replacement card.**
